Jeff has toured the Northwestern U.S., and performed in Mexico, Central America, Europe, Asia, and Australia. Pershing has opened for Albert King, Greg Allman, Chris Issak, Creedence Clearwater Revisited, Buffalo Springfield, The Ventures, Elvin Bishop, and many others.
